Focus On -

### North American Pairs Qualifying Games

During the months of June, July and August, clubs may run North American Pairs (NAP) qualifying games.

The purpose is to select the players who will advance all the way to the National event; to be held during the Fall 2019 NABC in San Francisco.

Players like the NAP games because of higher Master Point awards that are half Red and half Black.

After qualifying at the Club level, players may compete at the Unit and District levels.

To win an entry to the NABC event, players must successfully qualify at each level. The top four pairs in each bracket at

the District qualifying game may advance to the NABC.

Our Unit qualifying game will be scheduled sometime in September or early October. The District qualifying game will be at the Midwest City, OK Sectional, November 16-17, 2019.

#### A Bridge Hand By John Jennings

Here is a hand from the June 5th Razorback DBC game. It is a series of bidding problems. Your opponents were silent in the auction, so I have omitted their hands. Assume Standard American bidding.

#### North

- **♦** KJ3
- **♥** A
- ♦ AKQ975
- ♣ Q93

#### South

- **▲** AQ1076
- ♥ QJ985
- **4**
- ♣ KJ

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The auction with my comments: North -1D – This is a great hand but if your suit is a minor and your hand is unsuitable for NT, you need about 10 tricks to open a strong 2C. This hand is maybe 8 tricks.

South – 1S – When partner opens a minor and you have 4 cards in each major, bid 1H (up the line). If you have 5 cards in each major, respond 1 Spade; intending to rebid the lower ranking major twice.

North – 3C – This great hand has gotten better. No number of spades or diamonds can be right. You are perhaps strong enough to bid 3NT, but you could go down in that contract when 6S is cold. The jump shift to 3C is forcing to game and is best because all alternatives are worse.

South -3H – Natural. This can't be "4th suit forcing" because partner has already forced to game.

North - 3S - Natural

South -4C - A cue bid showing slam interest. This is usually first round control, but not always.

North – 4D – Cue bid – Cooperating.

South -4S – Willing to play there.

North -5H – Cue bid, slam try, despite partners "sign off".

South -6S – accepting partners' invitation.

This was a reasonable contract and it happened to make. The key bid was North's 5H call.

Some principles involved: 1) think before your speak (bid), 2) take partners bids in context, 3) asking for aces may not be the best approach in slam bidding, and 4) if in doubt, make a bid that offers partner a choice.
